- **6. Description of content:** The Order, signed on 17 June 2022, institutes the following emergency measures for the importation of FMD-susceptible animals and their products from Indonesia:
  - 1) Banning the importation of FMD-susceptible animals, their products and by-products;
  - 2) Immediate suspension of the processing, evaluation of the application and issuance of Sanitary and Phytosanitary (SPS) import clearance for the above-stated commodities;
  - 3) All shipments coming from Indonesia that are IN TRANSIT/LOADED/ACCEPTED UNTO PORT before the official communication of this Order to the Indonesian authorities shall be allowed provided the products were slaughtered/produced before 29 March 2022.

Nature of the urgent problem(s) and reason for urgent action: Based on the official report submitted by the Director General of Livestock and Animal Health Services, Livestock and Animal Health Services, Ministry of Agriculture, Jakarta, Indonesia to the World Organisation for Animal Health (WOAH) on 9 May 2022, there was an outbreak of Foot and Mouth Disease in Jawa Timur and Aceh, Indonesia affecting domestic cattle as confirmed by the National Center for Veterinary Biologics (National Laboratory).
