6. Description of content: This Technical Code was developed for the purpose of certifying communications equipment under regulation 14 of the Communications and Multimedia (Technical Standards) Regulations 2000 [*P.U.(A)* 124/2000].

This Technical Code specifies the minimum requirements for Maritime Radio Equipment designed for used in coastal stations and ship stations in Malaysia.

Objective and rationale, including the nature of urgent problems where applicable: To ensure that all maritime radiocommunications equipment that are designed for used in coastal stations and ship stations in Malaysia are certified according to the applicable Malaysian Standards, Technical Codes or through Declarations in accordance with the Communications and Multimedia Act 1998 [Act 588], its subsidiary legislations, statutory requirements and established rules and procedures.; Prevention of deceptive practices and consumer protection; Protection of human health or safety; Quality requirements
